1. Membership with Canada's Food & Agri-Tech Engine ("membership', "member", "members", "partner")

To join as a member, companies and organizations must complete **The Engine** Membership Subscription Form (Subscription Form)" based on the type of membership required:

- Knowledge & Development Partner
- Collaborative Partner
- Service Partner
- Corporate Partner

## **Subscription Terms and Conditions**

- Subscriptions are for a 1-year term, payable in monthly installments or on an annual basis
- All subscriptions are renewable on a yearly basis
  - Monthly subscriptions automatically renew at the anniversary date of the initial subscription
  - Annual subscriptions automatically renew at the anniversary date of the initial subscription
- Cancellation of subscriptions are governed by the Cancellation Policy herein outlined
- Subscriptions are non-transferable

#### 2. Payment Plans

Monthly and annual payment plans are offered for all subscription options. Through the Subscription Form companies will choose their preferred payment option. Payments will only be accepted by credit card (Visa, Mastercard or American Express). Direct invoicing is available for Corporate Partner subscriptions.

The monthly payment plan requires companies to commit to 12 monthly payments. This plan automatically renews annually, and these monthly payments will continue until formally cancelled in accordance with and as provided within the Cancellation Policy.

An annual payment plan is offered to companies wishing to take advantage of the discounted rate available. This discounted payment includes a savings equal to approximately 2 monthly payments. This plan renews annually and will continue until formally cancelled in accordance with and as provided within the Cancellation Policy.

The prices of subscription options are subject to change without notice. Changes will be effective on the annual subscription renewal date.

# 3. Subscription Change & Cancellation Policy

Changes to subscriptions can be made using the <u>Change Request Form</u>, including subscription cancellations. Subscription cancellations are not permitted within the first 6 months (180 days) of membership/partnership.
